## GET THE FACTS

### Why S-TACC

The S-TACC program was developed to assist families and schools with care coordination liaison services to community and natural resources. The program is geared toward youth who are being suspended and expelled from schools due to behaviors (sometimes violent and dangerous), and in many cases, left unsupervised.

The goal of the program is to monitor these youth, ensure they and the community remain safe, and assist the youth and their families in accessing and following through with the school safety team's recommendations to have the youth return to school.

This voluntary program assists the youth and their families in connecting to services with the intent to modify adverse behaviors as well as supporting them in/when returning to school.

### S-TACC communicates and assists in the development of linkages between:

- Behavioral Health Agencies
- School Administration
- School Counselors
- Teachers
- Clinicians
- Crisis Services
- Pediatricians
- Law enforcement agencies
- Family and/or Natural Supports
- Community Resources

### S-TACC Care Coordination Provides:

- Ongoing Measurement of service outcomes and evaluation of intervention effectiveness
- Regular Check-Ins with the Youth and/or Family (either in-person or by phone)
- Frequent updates and communication with the school and established Safety Team
- Referrals to Community Mental Health Agencies
- Referrals to Community Substance Use Disorder Treatment Agencies
- Referrals/Information Regarding Identified Youth/Family Needs by Safety Team

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
